Summary : CHP BOLO'd a victim, Corning resident, Ramirez, Eliseo (51 YOA) was chasing his stolen trailer and generator westbound CO RD 27 at Hwy 99w. OPD was back in route to Orland from the Glenn County Jail and was at that exact location, but was unable to locate the vehicles. Dispatch continued to provide the location, where OPD spotted the vehicle coming out of an orchard at CO RD D and CO RD 45.

The suspect vehicle, a grey, 2007, Dodge, Dakota no longer had the trailer or generator, but was stopped at Hwy 162 and I-5 for a moving violation. The driver, Esparto resident, Elizabeth Anne Henley (29 YOA) and passenger, Esparto resident, Jared Daniel Boles (32 YOA) were contacted and provided various stories why they were in the orchard. After an investigation and a K-9 search, Methamphetamine was located in the vehicle and the Dodge truck was determined stolen out of Fairfield California.

Evidence was located, linking them to the stolen trailer and generator, which they had dumped in the orchard they were coming out of. The truck was recovered and towed by L&T Towing. The trailer and generator were recovered and released to the owner.

Boles was arrested and booked into the Glenn County Jail for possession of Methamphetamine, grand theft and possession of stolen property. Henley was arrested and booked into the Glenn County Jail for possession of Methamphetamine, possession of stolen property, grand theft and stolen vehicle.
