

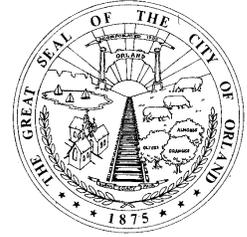

V. PUBLIC HEARING – Planning

1. **Stott Outdoor Advertising (Applicant): Conditional Use Permit # 2009-07:** to place and maintain a non-illuminated 7' x 14' (98 square feet) double-sided off-site pole sign with an overall height of 15'-6" to be located on Assessor’s Parcel Number 041-072-005 (7,637 square foot vacant lot) to market and advertise for Orland businesses. The property is zoned “C-2” (Community Commercial) and is designated in the General Plan as “Commercial” (C).

Environmental Review: Exempt under the CEQA “General Rule” Exemption (§15061 (b)(3)). The “General Rule” Exemption under CEQA states that where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA. The project meets this requirement.
