

Conflict of Interest Filing

Statement of Economic Interests – Form 700

The Political Reform Act requires public officials to disclose their personal financial information so the public may review that information and be knowledgeable that the official is not using his/her decision making authority to affect his/her personal financial interests. The Mayor, City Council, City Manager, City Treasurer, City Attorney and City Planning Commissioners file a Statement of Economic Interest no later than April 3rd this year. City employees in classifications that are granted with decision making authority also file a Statement of Economic Interest Form 700, as well as designated consultants and commission members.
